Making a Three Strand Thicker Yarn

First take some yarn, and loop it as shown below. The yarn shown here is fingering weight for a knitting machine. The bottom strand is attached to the reel, or ball of yarn you are using.



Begin crocheting, as shown below, up from the tail end, using the loop of the working yarn you created. You will always have three strands to work together.



When you get near the end of the three strands, take a loop of the working yarn and thread it through the loop in front of your work, as below, then pull it through, to the length you wish (it will be doubled). Continue to crochet as before, with three strands. Add more working loops as you need them.
