Linda Mooney was my main contact, I found out about her books etc., and she has been exceedingly helpful throughout. Not too happy with the way that fandom seems to have split a bit, we are supposed to be a family and should stick together, but then I guess there will always be differences in opinions etc., but don't let them spoil what we have. I think there are a few people who like me don't really like the undercurrents. But I try and ignore them (the undercurrents that is) and don't want to spoil my friendship with them, so I hear what is going on, and keep quiet.

#### 4) What do you enjoy most about the series?

I just love reading fan-fiction, always looking for new authors/stories - classic - am not a 3rd season fan unless it's SND!! I also love the cons, chance to meet up with my tunnel family and friends I haven't seen for a year.
